

VILLAGE OF GRAND MANAN
BY-LAW NO. 8-96

A By-Law Respecting The Stopping Up and Closing Of a Highway
Near Mark Hill In the Village of Grand Manan

Whereas it is determination of the Council of the Village of Grand Manan that the portion of the old highway located near Mark Hill is not required by the public for use;

It is hereby enacted as a By-Law of the Village of Grand Manan that the portion of highway known locally as the Old Highway and described as follows:

All and singular that certain lot, piece or parcel of land and premise situate, lying and being in the Village of Grand Manan, in the Parish of Grand Manan, in the County of Charlotte and described as follows to wit:

Being that portion of land described as the "Old Highway" as shown on the Plan of Survey, Portion of former highway north of existing Route 776, the Village of Grand Manan, Parish of Grand Manan, Charlotte County, New Brunswick, prepared by Hughes Surveys & Consultants Ltd. and dated January 23, 1996.

Is hereby stopped up and closed and all rights of the public traverse same are discontinued.
